1. **Gloucestershire Energy Strategy- Simon Roberts, Centre for Sustainable Energy**
An invite to contribute to the development of a new energy strategy for Gloucestershire The new strategy will set out how Gloucestershire can contribute fully to the national shift to a very low carbon, affordable and resilient energy system while maximising the benefits for local businesses and citizens.
2. **B2LC action plan launch – Rob Hargraves, Severn Wye Energy Agency**
B2LC project focusses on collaboration & learning between EU partners and sharing of best practices. This workshop outlines a range of activities developed by stakeholders to improve energy efficiency in homes.
